
Family Is At The Heart Of It All

I have been a caregiver all my life. My parents immigrated to the United States from Egypt in the 1970s. At an early age, both of my parents began to experience major health problems. Without any family here in the United States to support me, I have cared for both of my parents. Being a caregiver as many of you are familiar with has its ups and downs.

At the heart of it all, my family is the most important thing in my life. I consider it an honor to have been able to take care of my parents. My dad passed away in 2009 and years later, together with my husband, Alex, we still care for my mom. I am incredibly blessed to have a partner who is supportive and cares for my mom like a son. Alex is also incredibly supportive of my love to learn. I am in my first quarter of the Master of Business Administration (MBA) program at the University of California, Davis. I grew up an Aggie with my dad studying preventive and veterinary medicine at UC Davis in the 1980s and I followed with my love of science and public health completing my undergraduate at UC Davis.

Together, Alex and I started a business at the beginning of this year. Our business, Empowu, all started when my mom developed several health problems that severely limited her mobility and

ability to use a smartphone. At the same time, my mom was reluctant to let us know when she needed something to avoid feeling like she was interrupting or bothering us. Alex and I searched for a solution to address my mom's needs and couldn't find something that worked for our family. And thus, what we now call Empowu Connect was born, our first product. Empowu Connect is a wearable button that when pressed sends a sms text message to the caregiver, intended for non-emergency situations. When holding down the button, a phone call is made to the caregiver. In short, it's a communication device to help caregivers and those they care for to communicate with ease.

We are hoping this competition will provide the seed funding we need to bring our product to market at an accessible price. To do this we need to perform interviews asking you about your experience as caregivers, the challenges you face and how you address them today.
